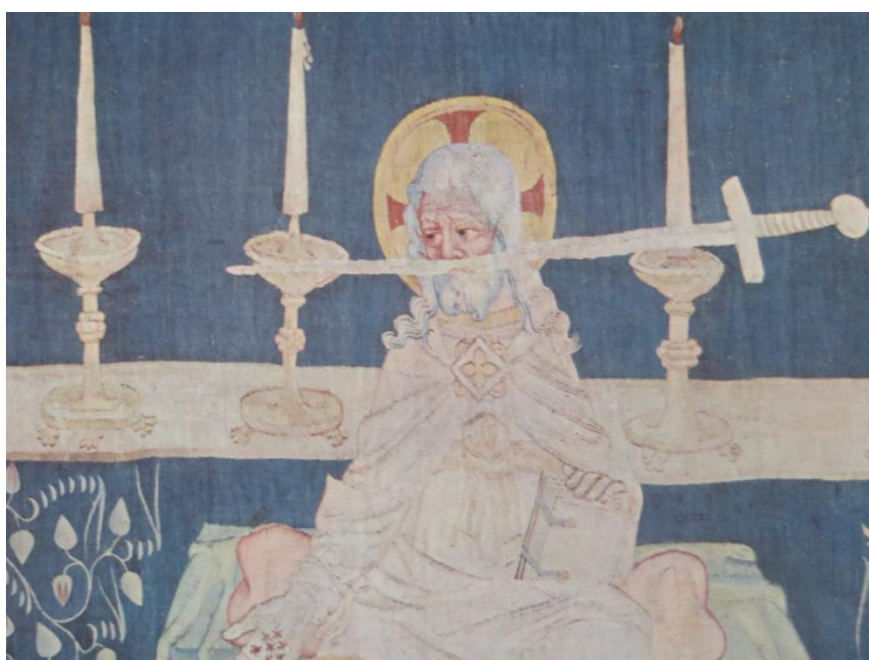

Facing our future

The Network team writes: Here is *Christ in Glory*, one of the 71 surviving tapestries of the Apocalypse of St John the Divine derived from the Christian New Testament *Book of Revelations*, weaved between 1377 and 1382, housed in the castle of Angers, France. The tapestry was created in a European world constantly devastated by famine, pestilence, war, conquest and death. The unusually mature Christ is shown with candles and book on one hand, the seven seals in his other hand, and with a sword between his teeth. A combination of light, wisdom, decisions and militancy, is what is needed now, to thwart Apocalypse Soon.
